


international community at large to increase their humanitarian intervention to save lives and minimize suffering.

5. We further call upon IGAD and the international community to quickly put in place mechanisms for monitoring and verification of the cease-fire already agreed so as to prevent violations and further escalation of the conflict.
6. As a country, the killing of people and continued fighting for control of territory is not the best way of addressing the current crisis. As parties concerned, we must focus on finding political settlement to the crisis by addressing comprehensively the underlying issues.
7. Finally, we take this opportunity to call upon President Salva Kiir Mayardit to set free the remaining four (4) detainees and also allow Dr. Peter Adwok Nyaba to travel, so that they can participate and contribute to the efforts in finding a lasting solution to the crisis in our country during these Peace Talks. We commend the on-going efforts by the IGAD Heads of State and the Special Envoys to secure the release of the four detainees. We re-iterate and re-affirm our commitment to a peaceful settlement of this national crisis.
